You completely release Facebook and/or other Social Media channels from any and all liability associated with this competition.

3. WHO CAN ENTER

- **VERY IMPORTANT:** The facilities in some cases are very basic this is not a luxury eco tour. This is a not-for-profit trip, funds raised from this trip go to the Orangutan Foundation International Care Centre.
- 5.7. In accepting this prize the winner and their companion **must arrange their own travel insurance.** Winners will be supplied with a travel insurance and indemnity form to complete and send back no later than one month prior to departure.
- In accepting this prize the winner and their companion understands and agrees to undertaking the **compulsory** inoculations and medical tests also necessary for this trip. The completed medical form signed and stamped by your doctor, along with a copy of your "negative" TB test result will be required as proof, and needs to be supplied <u>no later than Friday</u>, 13th March, 2020. - 5.9 In accepting this prize the winner and their companion will also need to start malaria pills prior to going to Borneo. This is highly recommended as the tour takes place in a known malaria area.
- 5.10. Prize value is correct as at the date of printing. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for change in prize value between now and the ultimate date on which the prize is taken.

- 6. In conjunction with clause 5, prize winners must abide by the following conditions:
 a) Winners and their companion must be able to travel between April 18 to 26th or prize is forfeited. These specific travel dates and arrangements are subject to Kobe Steeles Eco Tour b) Winner and their companion must hold eligible passport/all relevant visas.
- 7. Prizes detailed in clause 5 are not exchangeable, transferable or redeemable for cash and subject to the further terms and conditions below at 7.1 to 6.6.



You will spend time along river ways and walking through the forest looking at some of the most amazing wildlife on the planet, including proboscis monkeys, Bornean bearded pigs and hornbills.



You will visit the world famous Camp Leakey, and witness firsthand the amazing work of Dr Birute Mary Galdikas.

You will have the privilege to meet orphan orangutans at the Orangutan Foundation International Care Centre, where you can chat with staff and volunteers who have devoted their lives to the care and rehabilitation of these amazing animals.

You will come away with insights into one of human's closest living relatives and have a wildlife experience that others only dream of.







Itinerary

National Park

Day 1: Sunday, 19th April, 2020 Arrival at Jakarta airport. You will make your own way to the Bandara International Hotel. As people will be arriving at different times throughout the day, your day will be at leisure.

You will meet at 6.00pm this evening with Kobe Steele in the hotel for a group briefing.

Accommodation: Bandara International Hotel, Jakarta

Day 2: Monday, 20th April, 2020 Today we will take a flight from Jakarta to Pangkalanbun, Kalimantan. Upon arrival we will proceed by car to Kumai to board traditional klotok boats for a 2-3 hour cruise up the Sekonyer River to our jungle accomodation. Accommodation: Rimba Lodge, Tanjung Puting

Day 3: Tuesday, 21st April, 2020 After an early breakfast, we will cruise

upstream to Pondok Tanggui (feeding station #2). Feeding occurs each morning with time available afterwards for a gentle walk on the 3km loop track & a possible excursion further upstream in search of proboscis or long tailed macaque monkeys. We will then return to Rimba Lodge followed by an afternoon cruise a short way downstream to Pondok Harapan (feeding station #3).

Accommodation: Rimba Lodge, Tanjung Puting National Park

Day 4: Wednesday, 22nd April, 2020 After breakfast, we will visit the local village, then we will cruise upsteam to the tributary "black water" stream that ultimately leads to Camp Leakey (feeding station #1). Here we will witness the afternoon feeding & have time to walk many trails for possible sightings of orangutan.

Accommodation: Rimba Lodge, Tanjung Puting **National Park**

Day 5: Thursday, 23rd April, 2020 After breakfast, we cruise by klotok back to Kumai and then transfer to the OFI Care Centre near Pangkalanbun, where we will have the opportunity to see dozens of orphaned orangutans at various stages of rehabilitation. We will be fortunate enough to have the staff brief us about the operations at the Care Centre.

Accommodation: Grand Kecubung Hotel, Pangkalanbun

Day 6: Friday, 24th April, 2020

In the morning we will visit one of the soft release sites for orangutans who have graduated from OFI's rehabilitation program & are earmarked for release back into the wild. Free time in the afternoon to wander around the town or enjoy the swimming pool at the hotel after a busy week.

Accommodation: Grand Kecubung Hotel, Pangkalanbun

Day 7: Saturday, 25th April, 2020 Today you will take a flight from Pangkalanbun to Jakarta where our trip ends (flight time to be confirmed.



Flight Delays

Highlights

- Visit Tanjung Puting National Park, the base of Dr Birute Galdikas, world renown orangutan expert. Dr Galdikas was mentored by Dr Louis Leakey along with Dian Fossey and Jane Goodall. Camp Leakey, inside Tanjung Puting National Park, is the site of the longest continuous study by a principal investigator of any non-human wild animal.
- Visit the OFI Care Centre, normally closed to the general public, and see how orangutans are given special attention. Participants in this program are given exclusive access to the Care Centre.
- Walk through the forests of Tanjung Puting National Park with local Dayak guides.
- Cruise the Sekonyer River on a comfortable klotok river boat.
- See wild proboscis monkeys and magnificent tropical birds.
- Meet with OFI staff and volunteers and have a chance to ask questions.
- Visit a local village and understand the ongoing issue of resource management between people and orangutans.
- Stay at a comfortable rustic river eco lodge that was built especially for the Great Apes Conference in 1991.
- Assured multiple orangutan sightings at close proximity.
